What do the best learners in our school do differently to other learners?

Effective learners:

- Can articulate what they are learning and why
- Can talk about how they are learning – the strategies they are using to learn
 - Can be their own teacher

Effective learners:

- Can articulate their next learning steps
- · Can use self-regulation strategies
- Are assessment capable (they understand the assessment tools being used and what their results mean and can self-assess)

Effective learners:

- Seek, are resilient to and aspire to challenges
- · Can set mastery goals
- · Asks questions
- See errors as opportunities and are comfortable saying that they don't know and/or need help

Effective learners:

- · Positively supports their peers' learning
- Know what to do when they don't know what to do
- Actively seek feedback
- Have metacognitive skills and can talk about these (systematic planning, memory, abstract thinking, critical thinking, problem solving, etc.)
