



CONGRATULATIONS ANTHONY JOHN PAUL MOORE...



At the 8:30am Mass on Sunday 22nd August, Bishop James Foley celebrated the Admission to Candidacy Rite for Deacon Candidate Anthony John Paul Moore. Admission to candidacy for ordination comes about by means of a special liturgical rite, by which one who aspires to the diaconate or priesthood publicly manifests his will to offer himself to God and the Church, so that he may exercise sacred orders. The Church, accepting this offering, chooses and calls him to prepare himself to receive a sacred order, and in this way he is rightly numbered among candidates for the diaconate. Pictured above, candidate Anthony is granted admission to candidacy by Bishop James assisted by Father Neil, Reverend Professor Tony Kelly and Deacon Mark Cavicchiolo. Pictured above with Anthony is Bishop James. Anthony's wife Mannie attended the service along with Holy Cross student son James. The next step will be the Ordination to Deaconate in the Cathedral on 18th September. Anthony has been studying to become a Deacon for four years.

HOLY CROSS CONFERENCE ACTIVITIES 1/1/16 to 19/8/16



Requests' for emergency relief assistance has been quieter with an average of 20 per month as compared to 25 per month for the same period last year. However, the cases we are seeing have more complex needs and therefore requiring more substantial assistance. This year so far we have had 158 visits and have provided assistance to the value of \$15,493.20. This averages out to approximately \$33 more per case than we gave out last year.

Again this year the society will be assisting families who will experience difficulty getting their children back to school next year through the Children's Education Fund. This Fund is available for the children of low income families who receive Centrelink FTB A & B. The children from Prep to Year 12 qualify for the grant. It assists families with text books etc. and uniforms. It does not cover School Fees or Levies. If any member of the Council is aware of a family who will need assistance, please let me know by no later than 7th October. Applications need to be in Brisbane by the close on the 14th October.
