

#### 2. Previous Minutes – 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2017

Minutes received and approved by President, Secretary and Committee members.

#### **Outstanding Actions:**

- (1) Performance Shirts Sourcing dress shirts for children and meeting our brief is proving very difficult. Again the P&F agreed not to support Polo Shirts. The P&F agreed that trying to find "One" performance shirt to suit all uses for 80 children is where the problem lies. As it is apparent that we cannot move forward with the current proposal the P&F would like Christina to consider proposing smaller budgets for each group separately. ACTION: Mel to liaise with CW regarding different dress options for band / choir / liturgy.
- (2) Ashlyn's Holy Cross Bags Campaign A commemorative bag to be presented as a gift to each family at the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration. The School has committed \$1600. The P&F committed \$500 at the June Meeting but has since 'Executively Approved' an additional \$500 so that an order can be placed to have the bags supplied in time for the event.

ACTION: Ashlyn and Tony to order 450 bags, arrange logo and slogan, Marg Judd to alert media & TV etc. about the initiative.

(3) Fridge for Library: Approval for Purchase already Minuted (\$300 in May) ACTION: Mel and Hayley to purchase.

# **ADAM SCHMALZ - GRANTS UPDATE**

Application for Junior Landcare Grant of \$1000 has been submitted, summary of content provided. Unanimous approval and thanks to Adam for being proactive.

Gambling Community benefit fund – application due August. Up to \$35000 available. Sarah proposed application re supplying power to the shed to be used for the purpose of a Men's Shed – including the wider community. Other possibility raised is to use money toward bike education.

Other Grants being considered pending eligibility: Cairns Hardware Community Chest (\$500 - \$1000) Horizons (up to \$20 000)

ACTION: Adam to commence application process. The Bowes to assist with estimations of the actual cost for getting power to the sheds. Jim to assist in selecting and pricing of tools etc. if an option. Feedback at next meeting.
